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RESEARCH POLICY AND ESTABLISHMENT OF RESEARCH COMMITTEES

NIFTEM as its research policy has prioritized its areas of research as below:

- The outcome from the research should be able to solve some problem of the food industry
- The outcome of the research project should lead to some public good and should be in the interest of the public.
- The results from the project should be marketable
- The deliverables from the research project should result into opening of new vistas related to any of the food sector for further development

NIFTEM requires a well-structured system to promote and monitor high quality research. The overall objective of setting up of research committees is to address research activities in the following ways:

- To monitor and evaluate the progress of research being carried out by faculty and students of different Departments.
- To address the issues of facilities and removing the bottlenecks, if any.
- To monitor the progress of externally funded projects and facilitate their smooth and successful implementation.
- To ensure compliance of regulatory requirements of externally funded projects and in house research projects.
- Pre-assessment of research projects to be submitted to different funding agencies.
- Advice on acceptance of research grants provided by private agencies.
- Ensure that students research is in line with the mandate of NIFTEM

Composition of research committees shall be as follows:

(A) Research Advisory Committee:

A university level Research Advisory Committee with external experts to set up the guidelines of NIFTEM's research policies.

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(B) Internal Research Committees of NIFTEM

An internal Research Committee to look after the implementation of laid down policies by Research Advisory Committee and prescribed general guidelines.

1. Chairperson: Dean Research NIFTEM
2. Member Secretary: Associate Dean Research NIFTEM
3. Members:
 - HoD, FST
 - HoD, AES
 - HoD, FE
 - HoD, FBM
 - HoD, BAS

(C) Departmental Research Committees

Each Department shall have a Departmental Research Committee to look after the implementation of the policies and the general guidelines.

1. Chairperson : Head of the Department
2. Members : All faculty members who hold a Ph.D. degree

(D) Research Committees for the externally funded projects


In addition, each research project shall have a committee to advise on its implementation.

1. Dean Research.
2. Principal investigator of the project.
3. One senior faculty member of the Department.
4. External Expert.

(E) Student Advisory Committee

There shall be an Student Advisory Committee for each Ph.D. student.

The composition of Student Advisory Committee is notified in revised Ph.D. Guidelines.
