B.TECH (FOOD TECHNOLOGY AND MANAGEMENT) ADMISSION-2017 TENTATIVE ONLINE COUNSELLING SCHEDULE FOR PROVISIONAL ADMISSION - CATEGORY WISE:

- During the online counselling, candidates have to pay the admission fee of Rs.1,21,800 via online mode only (No DD/Cash transactions allowed). The fees deposited slip/bank transaction copy may be kept ready.
- During the online counselling, login with your id, password and enter all details. Finally, after provisional admission, download the necessary documents (list given as per guidelines given on website).
- Ensure bringing all the necessary certificates/documents which may be required to submit during the time of reporting at NIFTEM campus (as per guidelines given on website); for confirmed admission.
- The candidates have to pay admission fee through online SBI portal link provided on the website as per their counselling schedule which will be displayed on website (candidates are advised not to pay their admission fee until their name comes in counselling schedule/fee payment notification on website).
- The following is tentative schedule; hence candidates are advised to look for any updates on the NIFTEM website time to time.

Note: On 11/07/2017 or 12/7/2017, the counselling call list for open and reserved categories will be displayed on the website, but the payment mode will be activated for open category for first 90 candidates for first 3 working days, and then as per next counselling schedule the fees payment link will be activated accordingly, on the scheduled dates.

B. Tech Admission-2017 Counselling Sequence: Category wise

FIRST COUNSELLING:

➤ Step 1: First counselling for open category – 3 working days

First Counselling will begin for 90 seats under open category, based on JEE Main 2017 rank. Irrespective of category, top 90 candidates in merit list are eligible for admission (list uploaded on NIFTEM website).

> Counselling for KM category also begin along with this open category, since these seats are supernumerary quota)

> Step 2: First counselling for reserved category (OBC/SC/ST) -3 working days

The counselling would be strictly as per seat matrix under respective categories. Candidates belonging to each category from S.No.91 onwards to the end of the merit list would be called for counselling in the order of merit.

(By the end of 1st counselling, total 180 candidates would have been called from the merit list.)

SECOND COUNSELLING:

➤ Step 3 : Second counselling for open category –3 working days

Subject to the availability of seats in open category after step 1 of the 1st Counselling, irrespective of category, candidates who are in the waiting list (next to 180 candidates) would be called for subsequent counselling in the order of merit.

> Step 4: Second counselling for reserved category (OBC/SC/ST) -3 working days

Second Counselling for reserved categories will start after completion of open category second counselling. The remaining numbers of vacant seats under each reserved category, after step 2 will be filled by the candidates who are in the waiting list in each category, in the order of merit.

THIRD COUNSELLING:

➤ Step 5 : Third counselling for open category – 2 working days

The unfilled seats after step 3 will be filled by open category waiting list candidates in the order of merit.

➤ Step 6: Third counselling for reserved category (OBC/SC/ST)- 2 working days

Third Counselling for reserved categories will start after completion of open category third counselling. The remaining numbers of vacant seats under each reserved category, after step 4 will be filled by the candidates who are in the waiting list in each category, in the order of merit.

Note:

- a. In case of cancellation/withdrawal of seat, at any stage the remitting of the deposited fees will follow the guidelines given in the admission brochure, on NIFTEM Website.
- b. The conversion of vacant OBC seats to open seats would be done as per GOI rules.
- c. The conversion between SC and ST seats will be done as per GOI rules.
- d. Candidates are advised to regularly visit the NIFTEM website for Counselling updates/date and time.
- e. The unfilled seats (after counselling) will be further considered for allotment to the next candidates who are in the waiting list in the order of merit followed by category wise preference given by the candidates and the seat availability in the subsequent counselling. Hence, no claim (or) swapping for the seat based on category choice will be entertained from any of the candidate who has already been allotted/confirmed the seat or has deposited admission fee at any stage.
