FAQs - Ph.D. Admissions 2025

Question 1. Which departments are offering Ph.D. admissions under the Second Call 2025?

Ans. The following departments are open for admission under the second call:

- Food Science and Technology (FST)
- Food Business Management and Entrepreneurship Development (FBM&ED)
- Agriculture and Environmental Sciences (AES)
- Interdisciplinary Sciences (IDS)
- Food Engineering (FE)

Question 2. What is the total number of Ph.D. seats available in the second call?

Ans. A total of **57 seats** are tentatively available across all departments. Please note that the number of seats may increase or decrease based on applicant performance, departmental demand, and RET/interview results. Kindly refer NIFTEM-K website www.niftem.ac.in.

Question 3. What is the last date to apply for the second call?

Ans. The last date for submission of online applications against Call-2 is 20th June 2025 (Friday).

Ouestion 4. When will the list of shortlisted candidates be announced?

Ans. The list of provisionally selected candidates will be uploaded on 24th June 2025 (Monday).

Question 5. When will the RET and interviews be conducted?

Ans. RET will be conducted as per the following Schedule.

- RET: Stage-1, Stage-2 & Stage-3 (Interview) will be held on 1st July 2025 (Tuesday).
- The list of provisionally selected candidates will be uploaded on 4th July 2025 (Friday).

Question 6. I already applied under the First Call. Do I need to apply again for the Second Call? Ans. No, the candidates who applied/appeared in response to the First Call do not need apply again. However, they must send a consent email confirming their willingness to be considered under the second call at: admission@niftem.ac.in.

Question 7. Can I update any information submitted in the First Call?

Ans. Yes. If you need to update details such as degree awarded, mode of admission award of NET/JRF/SRF etc., please email the updated documents to **admission@niftem.ac.in.**

Question 8. If I qualified RET Stage-1 in the First Call, do I need to appear for it again? Ans. No. Candidates who cleared RET Stage-1 on 9th June 2025 need not appear again for RET Stage-1. However, they must appear for RET Stage-2 and the RET stage-3(interview) as the case may be.

Question 9. Is the second call (call-2) open for Industry/Academia Sponsored candidates also? Yes, the Second Call is open for Industry/Academia Sponsored candidates. Such candidates are required to appear only for RET Stage-3 (Interview) as per the Ph.D. admission guidelines notified in the admission brochure.

Question 10. What is the process for Industry/Academia sponsored candidates or those with JRF/SRF/National Fellowships?

Ans. These candidates are required to appear only for RET Stage-3 (Interview) on the date mentioned in the Admission notice.

Question 11. Where can I find the RET syllabus and admission process details?

Ans. All details related to mode of admission, RET syllabus, and the Ph.D. admission process are available in the **Admission Brochure 2025** on the official website: www.niftem.ac.in

Question 12. I had successfully submitted my Ph.D. application against the First Call (notified on 22-04-2025) but did not appear for any of the RET stages. Do I need to apply again for the Second Call?

Ans. No, you do not need to apply again. However, you must send a consent email confirming your willingness to be considered for the Second Call to admission@niftem.ac.in.

Your application will be considered for Call-2 based on the consent received and need to follow admission process as per the details given in admission brochure and call-2 notification.

Question 13. I already applied under the First Call and appeared for the admission process but was not selected. Do I need to apply again for the Second Call?

Ans. No, you **do not need to apply again**. Your application will automatically be considered for the Second Call. However, you must send a **consent email** confirming your willingness to participate in the Second Call to: admission@niftem.ac.in.

The selection process of these kinds of candidates is to be followed as mentioned in response to Question no. 7 above.

Question 14. Is there any specific requirement for Industry/Academia Sponsored candidates? Ans. Yes, Industry/Academia Sponsored candidates must fulfill the following requirements:

- A sponsorship letter/ No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the employer is mandatory, clearly stating that the candidate will be permitted to pursue the Ph.D. program at NIFTEM-K.
- Such candidates are **exempted from RET Stage-1 and Stage-2** and are required to appear for **RET Stage-3 (Interview)** only.

Question 15. Is a No Objection Certificate (NOC) mandatory for Industry/Academia Sponsored candidates to appear in the interview?

Ans. Yes, a No Objection Certificate (NOC) is mandatory for all Industry/Academia Sponsored candidates. The NOC must clearly state that the employer has no objection to the candidate pursuing a Ph.D. at NIFTEM-K.

However, candidates whose **NOC process is still underway** must submit a **proof of request** made to their employer (e.g., acknowledgment or application copy).

Such candidates will be **allowed to appear for the interview (RET Stage-3)** based on this proof, but they **must submit the original NOC at the time of joining** the Ph.D. program at NIFTEM-K. Otherwise their candidature will be considered null and void.

All other eligibility criteria and documentation must be met as specified in the **Ph.D. Admission Brochure 2025** available at www.niftem.ac.in.

Question 16. Will the RET examination be conducted in online mode?

Ans. No, the RET examination will **not be conducted in online mode**. It will be held in **offline** (**physical**) **mode** at the NIFTEM-K campus.

Candidates are advised to regularly check the official website (<u>www.niftem.ac.in</u>) for detailed schedule, venue, and related instructions.

Question 17. Is there any possibility of a change in the RET schedule for Call-2?

Ans. As of now, the RET for Call-2 is scheduled to be conducted on 1st July 2025.

However, any changes in the schedule (if necessary) will be notified through the official NIFTEM-K website (www.niftem.ac.in) and/or via registered email.
