

Scope of Certification:

FFCA's certification activities cover the following categories within its approved scope:

Category K – Food and Food Products: Premixes

Certification of applicable **food fortification premixes** in accordance with the relevant certification scheme and specified requirements.

Category C4 – Ambient Stable Products

Certification of applicable **ambient stable food products**, including fortified products, in accordance with the relevant certification scheme and specified requirements. **Certification is provided only for products and activities falling within FFCA's approved certification scope.**

Certification Process

FFCA follows a structured certification process designed to ensure objective and consistent evaluation of conformity.

The certification process may include:

- Application and application review
- Evaluation of applicable documentation and requirements
- Assessment and conformity evaluation
- Review of assessment findings and objective evidence
- Independent certification decision
- Granting, maintaining, suspending, withdrawing, or reducing certification, as applicable
- Surveillance or other applicable certification activities
- Management of complaints and appeals
- Maintenance of certification records and applicable certification information

Certification decisions are made based on **objective evidence and applicable certification requirements.**
