Subject: Implementation of Promotion Policy approved under Academic Regulations.

The Academic Council in its 16th Meeting held on 09.02.2018 directed that an uniform promotion policy should be followed for promotion at NIFTEM and accordingly all students (old and new) should be promoted to next year of study if they do not have more than 04 back papers of any semester/year.

The revised UG & PG Regulations notified vide Notification No. N/S/K/1531/2018/Notification/253 dated 03.01.2018 are accordingly modified as per Academic Council approval, as mentioned below:

Regulation – V: Promotion & Classification of Result- sub-para (ii) relating to promotion of students having back papers:-

Existing Regulation Promotion for B.Tech Programme 1st year to 2nd year:

(ii) A student having not more than 4 back papers ('F', 'I' or 'X' Grades) in 1st & 2nd semesters taken together shall be provisionally promoted.

2nd Year to 3rd year

(ii) A student having not more than 4 back papers ('F', 'I' or 'X' Grades) in 3rd & 4th semesters taken together and has cleared all papers of 1st & 2nd semester shall be provisionally promoted.

3rd Year to 4th year

(ii) A student having not more than 4 back papers ('F', 'I' or 'X' Grades) in 5th & 6th semesters taken together and cleared all papers of 1st to 4th semester shall be provisionally promoted.

4th Year to Pass out

(ii) A student, who has back papers pertaining to 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th Semesters, shall register in the 5th year for the back paper(s) of

Revised Regulation

1st year to 2nd year: No change

2nd year to 3rd year:

A student having not more than 4 back papers ('F', 'I' or 'X' Grades) in 1st to 4th semesters taken together shall be provisionally promoted.

3rd year to 4th year:

A student having not more than 4 back papers ('F', 'I' or 'X' Grades) in 1st to 6th semesters taken together shall be provisionally promoted.

4th year to pass out:

A student who has back papers from semester 1st to 8th shall register in the 5th year for the back paper(s) of corresponding semester(s) as an external

Regulation – 2: Promotion & Classification of Result- sub-para 2.5.5 relating to promotion of students having back papers:-

Existing Regulation
Promotion for M.Tech Programme
1 st year to 2 nd year:

A student having not more than 4 back papers ('F', 'I' or 'X' Grades) in 1st & 2nd semesters taken together shall be provisionally promoted.

2nd Year to Pass out

A student, who has back papers pertaining to 3rd and 4th Semesters, shall register in the3rd year for the back paper(s) of corresponding semester(s) as an external student on payment of a fee of Rs. 1000/- per subject.

Revised Regulation

Promotion for M.Tech & MBA
Programme

1st year to 2nd year: No change

2nd year to pass out:

A student who has back papers from semester 1st to 4th shall register in the 3rd year for the back paper(s) of corresponding semester(s) as an external student on payment of a fee of Rs. 1000/-per subject.

The above changes shall uniformly be applicable to all UG/PG students irrespective of batch to which they belong.
